FIDDLE TOYS

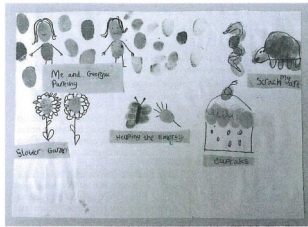
An email was sent out about this earlier this week, but a gentle reminder that toys should not be brought into school.

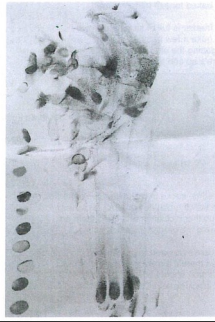

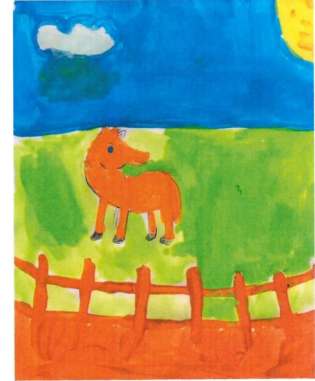
