

## Year 1 Classes 3 and 4, Autumn Term 2 2020 - 'Marvellous Me!'

### Phonics

We will be reviewing the trigraphs 'air, ure and ear' sounds as well as segmenting and blending these in words. We will then be introducing Phase 5 Set 1 sounds.



### English

Books that we will be sharing in class: You Choose, You Choose Your Dreams, Astro Girl, Look Up, Whose Baby?, The Growing Story, Titch and The Christmas Story.

In writing, we will be focusing on: Sentence Writing, Personal Recounts, Recall of information using a non-fiction text, Fact Files, Character diary, retelling a story, character study and Oral recount using story telling hands and songs (The Christmas Story).

We will also be focusing on fine motor skills and for letter formation practicing long ladders and zig-zag letter families.

### Art

We will be drawing/creating self-portraits using different media. We will explore pop art and the use of colour/pattern studying the work of the famous artist Andy Warhol.

### History

We will talk about changes as we grow from babies to adults-we will be looking at photographs, books and artefacts. We will create simple timelines and make comparisons between the past and the present. As a school we will be recognising the significant events of Bonfire Night and Remembrance Day.

### Topic

Geography-We will be talking about where we live and naming and locating the four countries and capital cities of the UK and the surrounding oceans.

Science-We will be exploring and investigating the five human senses.

### Music

We will be identifying the key elements of pitch and rhythm in a range of songs/music. We will be studying the genre 'Old School Hip Hop'. We will also be learning songs related to 'The Christmas Story'.

### Keeping Active

We will be using the outdoor areas to practice the fundamental key skills and to further develop our core strength. (Class 3 – Tues, Class 4 – Thurs)

We will continue with daily 'Coalway Blast' using Go Noodle, Yoga and the outdoor track.

### Maths

We will continue to explore number bonds to 10- addition and subtraction facts. The children will be solving number problems and applying their knowledge of number bonds to 10. We will be using 'part-part / whole' models, concrete objects and pictorial images to support our learning. Counting on and counting back (to and from 10) will also be a key skill this term.

We will be recognising, naming and sorting 2D and 3D shapes. We will practise counting, writing and ordering numbers to 20 and partitioning numbers into tens and ones.

### PSHE

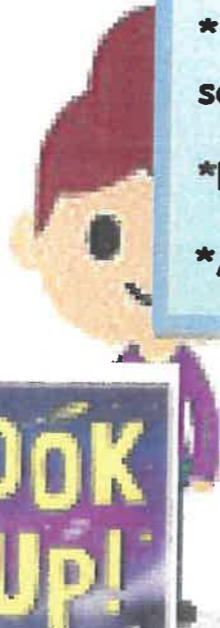
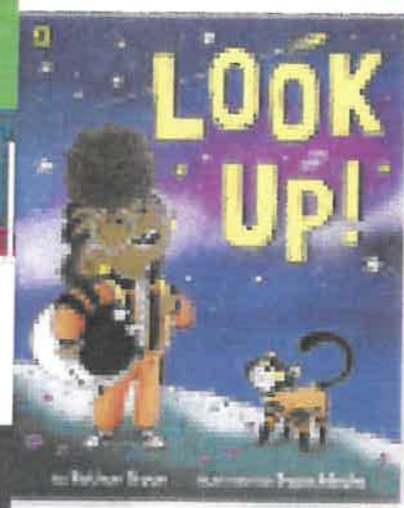
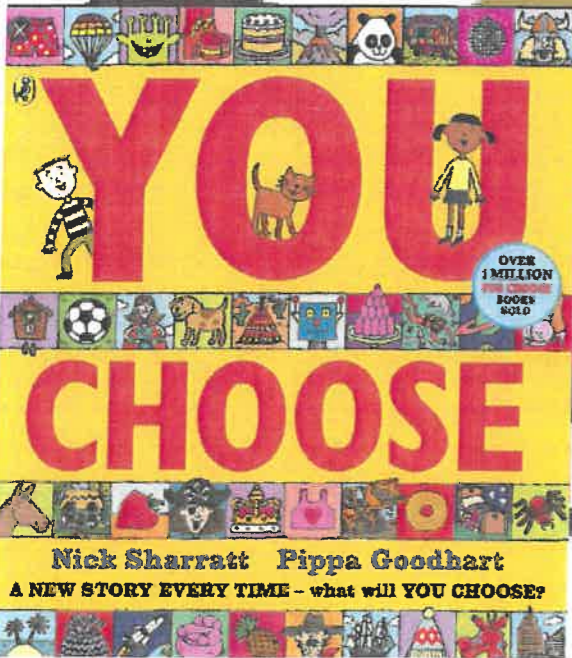
We will be discussing keeping safe on bonfire night (firework safety rules).
