

From Field to Fork – Year 2

Maths

Read and write numbers up to at least 100 in numerals and words

Recognise the place value of each digit in a two digit number

Identify, represent and estimate numbers using different representations including the number line

Compare and order numbers from 0 upto 100 using $<$, $>$ and $=$

Use place value and number facts to solve problems.

Count in steps of 2, 3 and 5 from 0 and in 10's from any number, forwards and backwards.

Recall and use addition and subtraction facts to 20 fluently.

Add and subtract numbers using concrete objects, pictorial representations and mentally, including a two digit number and ones; a two digit number and tens; two two-digit numbers; adding three one-digit numbers.

Solve problems with addition and subtraction

Recognise and use the inverse relationship between addition and subtraction and use this to check calculations and solve missing number problems.

Science – Animals (including humans)

- notice that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults
- find out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air)
- describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene
