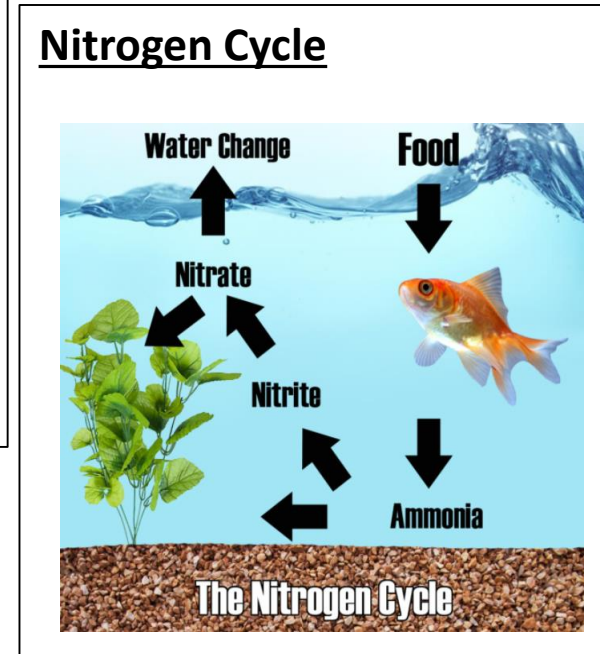
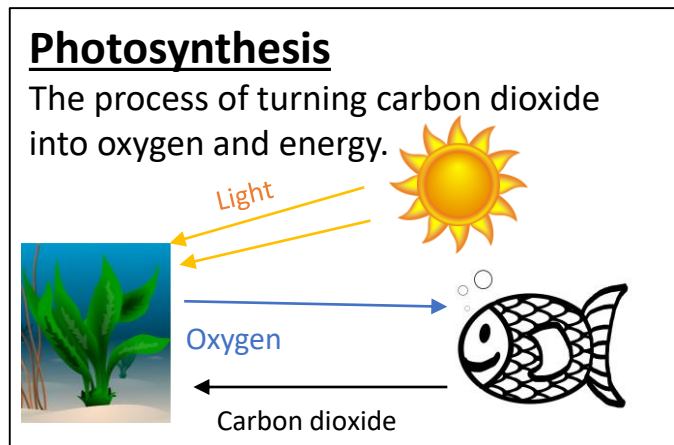
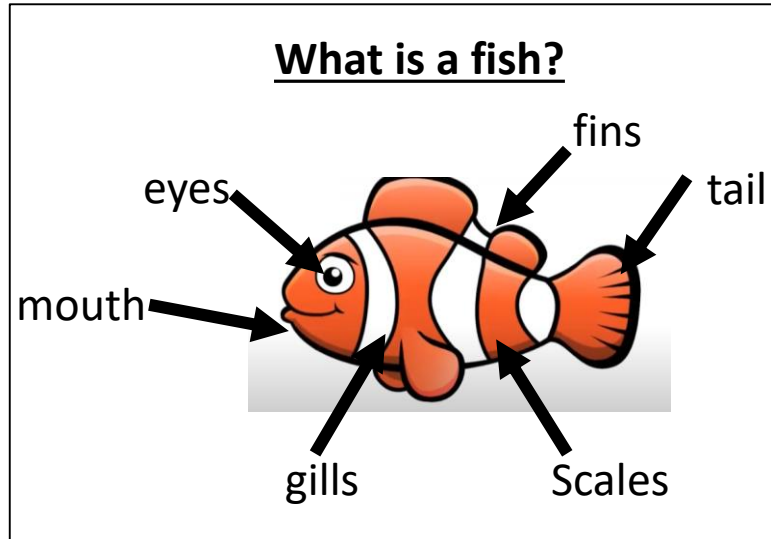


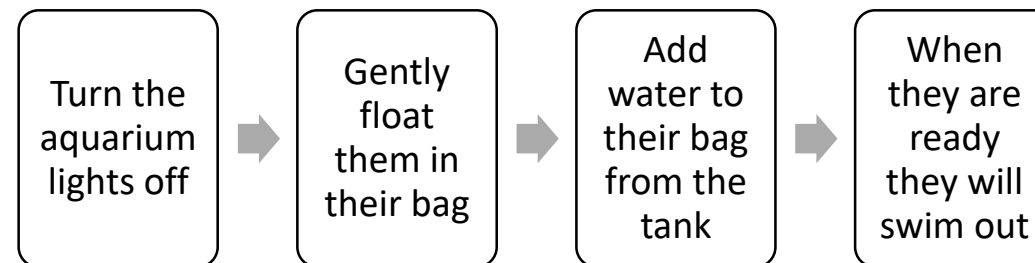


# Year 3 Science – Fishkeeper Fry Programme - How to care for our fish

|----------------|---|
| Species        | A group of similar living animals.                  |
| Lateral Line   | Fish use this to sense water movement and pressure. |
| Aquarium       | The home where fish live.                           |
| Fry            | Young fish  |
| Acid water     | Sharp water   |
| Alkaline water | Salty water   |
| pH             | The way we test water                               |
| Ammonia        | A harmful chemical found in water                   |
| Nitrites       | A harmful chemical found in water                   |
| Nitrates       | Builds up over time. Can be harmful to fish         |
| Carnivore      | Animal that eats meat                               |
| Herbivore      | Animal that eats plants                             |
| Omnivore       | Animal that eats meat and plants                    |
