Oral rehearsal – practise using sequencing vocabulary (see words list on SeeSaw) to say a recount of your walk out loud (record an audio)	Writing a recount of your local walk using sequencing vocabulary. Start each sentence with a sequencing word and remember to recount your walk in order.
