A group of 11 Year 5 children from Georgian Gardens CP School, in Rustington, had an amazing day at Hove County Cricket ground on the 7th May, watching Sussex play Glamorgan in the Royal London One-Day Cup.

This was part of the "Chance to Shine" program run by Sussex Cricket Foundation, which also included a Sussex Cricket Coach running a workshop for an afternoon with all of our Year 2 children and a Year 1 cricket based multiskills morning at Durrington High School. The "Chance to Shine" program aims to raise the profile of the Sussex Cricket Foundation through its work with schools.

Georgian Gardens School was able to access the "Chance to Shine" program by entering their Inter-school indoor and outdoor cricket competitions this year.

The children really enjoyed the cricket and the skills activities they took part in at the County Ground, along with hundreds of children from other local schools and even appeared on Sky Sports during the day, whilst cheering on the two teams.
