As part of their science work in their Green Finger topic, Class 2 have been experimenting to see which conditions plants prefer.



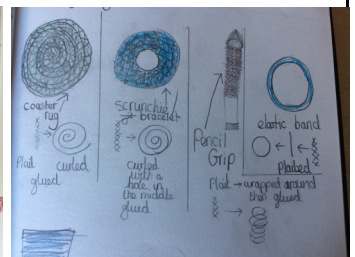
They have also carried on their work with the Turning Tides project, this week playing the ukuleles. Well done Class 2.
