# How to vote for your play structures!

Try to get at least 5 adults to do the following (or better still, sit down with them and go through it with them to make sure they do it!):

On a computer/laptop/phone go to [www.calor.co.uk/shop/communityfund](http://www.calor.co.uk/shop/communityfund)  
Register with your name, email and a pass word.

A verification email is sent to your inbox (for some reason this has been delayed in arriving for some people, so keep an eye on your inbox if it is not sent immediately & see note below).

Click the link in the email to the activate your account.

Now you can vote. To do so click on 'Vote for projects' on the home page at the above web address.

You get 10 votes so spend them all on our project. To find it type 'Outdoor community fund' in the search box and click the red 'Go' button.

Scroll down a bit and you'll see our project with the picture of the Jungle hut. Click on the 'View Project' red button below the picture.

Now you'll see a big picture of the hut and a 'Vote for this Project' button to the right of it. Click on it.

The button goes grey and there is a white box above with 'please select' written in it and a drop-down arrow at the end, click on the arrow and select 10.

Now click on the red 'Submit' button. All done!
