



If this is the case, SLT to ensure all staff and the rest of their class or group are sent home and advised to self-isolate for 10 days. Window to be kept open.</p> <p>Parent is instructed to call 119 and arrange test. They should self-isolate for 10 days. Request that test results are shared as soon as available. If test is positive, the rest of their class or group should be sent home and advised to self-isolate for 10 days. The other household members of that wider class or group do not need to self-isolate unless the child, young person or staff member they live with in that group subsequently develops symptoms.</p>

CCE CEO and Premises Manager informed and PHE consulted throughout.</p> <p>Bubbles and record-keeping of visitors / wraparound provision allows for identification of anyone in contact with confirmed case.</p> <p>Site supervisor would ensure rooms locked as needed and fogging cleaning system employed with deep clean to follow.</p>

<p>Staff timetable in place. Most staff in one bubble only. Limited movement around school during school day.</p> <p>Social distancing posters and markings in place in common areas / corridors.</p> <p>Where staff need to work with another bubble, they should maintain 2m distance with pupils and adults in the bubble.</p> <p>Classes are drawn up and each class bubble is allocated a teacher and at least 1 full time TA. PPA will be staffed by an HLTA, where possible this will be the class TA.</p> <p>Staff should avoid entering another bubble unless timetabled to do so. If they do so, masks should be worn and close contact limited – remain 2m away from pupils and staff / limit face to face contact / contact within 1m.</p> <p>Bubbles allocated own classroom and stay in that room / no crossing bubbles.</p> <p>All bubbles are single classes except Reception, where the 2 classes make one bubble due to class layout / facilities and in KS1 where some cross-class teaching of small groups for Read, Write Inc only is timetabled. These groups are consistent, in a regular space, which is cleaned after use, and records are kept of daily attendance in group. When groups of more than 1 class are placed together, effort must be made to employ 2m distancing between the pupils of each class, thereby minimising close contact.</p>

<p>Each class bubble has their own designated class and play area each day. Pupils do not mix with pupils from other bubbles. (Small number of pupils attending after-school club are in phase bubbles, seated in separate areas to enable socialisation at this time)</p> <p>Adventure play equipment is out of bounds. Play resources, allocated for each bubble, are to be used. Any resources that are shared are to be cleaned as soon as they are finished with or quarantined for 72 hours. When wet, strict times for hard playgrounds to be adhered to.</p> <p>Each bubble has identified break times / outdoor space / handwashing facilities. Each child has own frequently used items.</p>

<p>Classes have identified handwashing facilities which are used by one bubble at a time. These are cleaned 3x per day in KS1 and LKS2 and 2x per day in EYFS and UKS2 where less pupils are using them. Hand sanitiser dispensers are installed throughout the school, near to exterior doors to enable sanitising after outdoor play. Handwashing preferred method before eating. Handwashing schedule in place for all pupils. Staff reminded to wash / sanitise hands frequently. Signage in place as a reminder.</p>

Hand sanitiser at other times so over-use is avoided. Parents have been asked to inform us if they DO NOT wish child to use sanitiser. The wishes of any parent not wishing their child to use sanitiser must be acknowledged and complied with.

Limited movement around building. Staff to maintain 2m distance (signage and markings in place to remind staff). Staff to hand sanitise before entering and upon leaving bubble. Staff to refrain from entering another bubble unless timetabled to be there. Reduce PPA cover being delivered by TAs not usually timetabled to class. If needing to be there, staff must maintain 2m distance and hand wash / sanitise frequently. If making lesson visits, masks should be worn and close contact limited – remain 2m away from pupils and staff / limit face to face contact / contact within 1m.

Frequently-used equipment should not be shared. Pupils to have own equipment in named trays/pots/pencil cases, on tables. Equipment that is shared within bubbles must be cleaned more frequently. Where equipment is shared with another bubble, this should be cleaned with anti-bac spray straight away and staff member should wash hands afterwards. If not possible to clean, resources, must be quarantined for 72 hours.

All shared facilities are subject to increased cleaning regime. x3 per day in KS1 and LKS2 / x2 in EYFS and UKS2 staff room/office areas as well as at end of day by cleaners. A cleaning rota / checklist is in place to ensure this is completed. No water fountains. Children bring own drinks bottles. When school cups are used, these are washed in the dishwasher - no handwashing.

Pupils should refrain from physical contact - staff to make this clear through reiterating 'Rules for health'.  Bubbles in allocated spaces - indoors and out - so there should be no cross-contamination across bubbles.
