Our whole school attendance is 96.8% (12.10.15)

So far, 56 children have attendance below 95% and 28 of them are below 90%. This means on average they have already lost either 1.3 or 2.6 days of education out of a possible 26 days. Since the beginning of term, this equates to 109.2 days of lost teaching time, which will never be regained.
