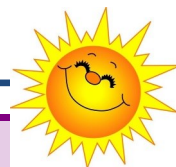
A massive congratulations to the seven children that received awards at the STALC celebration! They were given their trophy by Steve Double MP in front of an audience of almost 400 at St John's Church.
