Behaviour and attitudes

The behaviour and attitudes of most of our children is excellent and they continue to be a credit to their families! We will be expecting hard work, effort, good manners and excellent behaviour from all children. The staff have been working at refreshing the behaviour code and this was introduced to the children by Mr Lees on Monday 4th January 2016.

We live our school lives by the **BB Rules for Life**. If we break them, there are several consequences. All of our children start the week with 30 minutes of golden time and will lose some of this if they break the rules. This term we will be working hard to eradicate low level disruption in class and stopping other children from learning. If this happens, they will receive up to three warnings (**three strikes and you are out!**). If they fail to correct their behaviour, they will be sent to morning playtime detention. Also we will be asking the children to play nicely outside and any rough play will end with the consequence of staying off the playground for three days and parents being informed.

We expect everyone to work hard and do their best and I am pleased to say that the overwhelming majority of your children always do this!

We have a zero tolerance toward bullying in any form. Please let us know if you discover any problems and more importantly encourage your child to tell us. Thank you.
