### Policy on Uniform

As with many schools across the UK our School currently has a uniform. We believe that a uniform and the presentation of the children give a feeling of belonging, encouraging co-operation, common goals and team spirit. It is also beneficial in maintaining standards of dress and behaviour.

The school uniform was implemented following discussions with Governors and staff and is reviewed regularly.

Currently our uniform comprises of the following:-

#### **WINTER UNIFORM**

Navy blue skirt or pinafore dress  
Navy blue school trousers (**NOT** jeans, hipsters, tracksuits, etc)  
School sweatshirt/cardigan with logo  
White polo shirt or white shirt  
**Sensible flat** shoes NOT trainers – BLACK

#### **SUMMER UNIFORM**

Red/white checked dress  
Navy trousers or shorts  
White polo shirt or white shirt  
School sweatshirt/cardigan with logo

Socks – These should be **plain** navy, black, white or grey.

Tights – These should be **plain** navy, black, red, white or grey.

The school sweatshirt/cardigan, white polo shirt, PE t-shirt and red shorts are available from School. Other items can be purchased from many local departmental stores. Everyone is aware of the cost of clothing and we would urge you to **label every item** of your child's clothing **clearly** to avoid loss.

All children take part in PE and, as such, are required to change for this activity.

The uniform for PE is as follows:-

Coloured PE t-shirt with logo  
Red shorts  
Black plimsolls  
Football boots/trainers for outdoor games (KS2 only)  
Tracksuits may be worn for outdoor games during inclement weather.

Please note that in the interests of personal hygiene, the PE t-shirt should **ONLY** be worn for PE and must, therefore, be changed after each PE lesson.

Jewellery should not be worn for any PE or sporting activity, earrings must either be removed for PE or covered with tape supplied by the parents.

Many children in KS2 wear watches to school which need to be removed for PE and games. If children do wear watches to school they are solely the responsibility of the child/parent.

In the interests of safety we do not allow the wearing of ankle/wrist bracelets, chains or necklaces. We request that children do not use make-up of any kind, especially nail polish. Only stud earrings should be worn to school.

We ask parents to ensure that children's hair styles do not include shaved patterns or full shaving. Any hair that is longer than shoulder length should be tied back. Hair clips, bands or bows should be **small** and solely for the purpose of holding the hair in place. They can be blue, white, black, red, silver or gold.

If any items of uniform are lost we do have a lost property box, which is located by the front office. Please feel free to ask a member of staff to look for any 'lost items'. If items are found which are clearly labelled they will be returned to the child as soon as possible.

Periodically lost property is displayed at the front of school where parents/children can check for 'lost items'. If clothing is not collected from this display then it will be recycled through our clothing collection container.
