<p>The children will be exploring their sense of smell. Which smells do they like and dislike? Do they recognise the smell?</p> <p><i>At home: Which smells can your children detect in your home and when you are out and about? What is their favourite smell?</i></p> <p>RE</p> <p>We will be re-visiting the big question ‘Why is welcome important?’ What have the children remembered?</p> <p>We will share bible stories with the children and we will encourage the children to draw pictures of a baptism.</p>	<p>Over the last few weeks we have learnt the story of Charlie Chicken off by heart. The children have learnt the actions and enjoy telling the story aloud.</p> <p>They have been using their own ideas to change the Charlie Chicken story in to a different one. As a class we have chosen a new main character, different locations and different actions.</p> <p>This week we will be asking the children to tell us a story which we will then write down for them. We hope to see the children being more confident and imaginative with story- telling than they were at the beginning of the academic year.</p>	<p>We are introducing phonics to the children using Ruth Miskin cards. These will be displayed in your child’s classroom for you to look at. This week’s sounds are:</p> <p>ff – as in ‘huff’ and ‘puff’</p> <p>ll – as in ‘bell’ and ‘sell’</p> <p>ss – as in ‘hiss’ and ‘bliss’</p> <p><i>At home: look out for these letters in the books you share with your child. Practice saying the sounds these letters make.
