# Transition

- ▶ 'Move Up' morning
- ▶ Several story time sessions where we have been over to Early Years
- ▶ Children have been shown round by the current Year 1 pupils
- ▶ Communication between Early Years and Year 1 teachers
- ▶ In September - similar feel to Early Years
- ▶ As the year progresses - children will begin to work for longer periods at tables
- ▶ After Easter - getting the children ready for Year 2

# The Learning Environment

- ▶ Two classrooms next door to each other
- ▶ Both have their own cloakroom and toilet
- ▶ Access to a shared outdoor area
- ▶ 1B - Enter and exit via the KS1 playground
- ▶ 1H - Enter and exit via the front courtyard
- ▶ The doors will be open in the mornings at 8:45am and the children will leave at 3:20pm
- ▶ Both classes have their own role play area, which will change each term
- ▶ We will be encouraging independence
  - Children will be able to access their own resources
  - After two weeks, parents are encouraged to say goodbye at the door
  - Children quickly learn to organise themselves at the beginning and end of the day

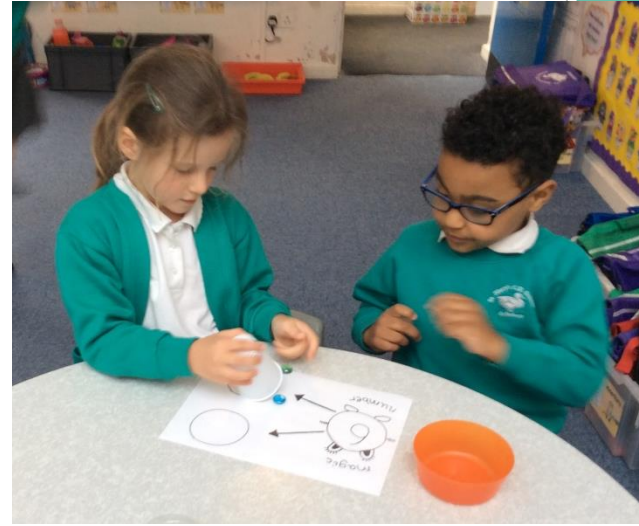


# Read Write Inc.

- ▶ Children will continue to follow the Read Write Inc. scheme in Year 1.
- ▶ Children are grouped by ability and work will match this level to enable them to make good progress.
- ▶ They will be taught by a range of adults within the Year 1 team and will regularly change groups to match their level.
- ▶ Read Write Inc. lessons will be four times a week and cross curricular writing will take place alongside this to enable children to apply their phonics skills.
- ▶ Read Write Inc. information evening will be arranged for the Autumn term.

# Maths in Year 1

- ▶ New Inspire Maths scheme that the whole school are following as of September
- ▶ Hands on, practical tasks using equipment
- ▶ Questioning
- ▶ Mastery - before moving on



# Reading in Year 1

- ▶ Children will have one reading book to bring home, which are changed weekly. We always appreciate comments from parents about how your child is getting on.
- ▶ This book will reflect their reading ability and will be regularly checked by their class teacher.
- ▶ Teachers hear children read daily in Read Write Inc lessons and weekly in group Guided Reading sessions.
- ▶ Library visit once a week - children can borrow a book of their choice.



# Topic Based Learning

- ▶ Our afternoon lessons will cover all other areas of the curriculum.
- ▶ Lessons will usually be linked our topic or theme that term.
- ▶ Stay and Play sessions - once a term





# Homework

- ▶ Children will have a homework folder.
- ▶ Homework will be put inside on a Friday.
- ▶ The task will usually be Maths/Phonics based or linked to our current topic.
- ▶ The homework task should only ever take 20 minutes.

# Clubs & Trips

- ▶ Key Stage 1 staff run a range of clubs for Year 1 and 2.
- ▶ Woburn Safari Park trip - Summer term
- ▶ Forest School - three sessions
