FLU VACCINATIONS

Yesterday 245 children from Reception to Y5 received the flu vaccine. Virgin Medical have contacted us and asked us to let you know about the additional clinics they are running, to offer the vaccine to any children in that age group who have missed this opportunity.
To access these clinics, you must book in advance on the dedicated booking line by ringing 01392 356141 on a Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday between 9.30am – 3pm to book your child's appointment. Only children with a booked appointment will be seen at the clinic, due to anticipated high demand. Unfortunately, they cannot offer walk in appointments on the day.
The three local clinics are on Monday 10th and Wednesday 12th December, from 3.30pm - 6.45pm and on Saturday 15th December from 09.30am at Estover Surgery, Leypark Walk, Plymouth, PL6 8UE. There are others available across Devon on different days.

PHOTOGRAPHS / PUBLICITY



Parents / grandparents sometimes take photographs or videos of their children in school activities e.g. Celebrations of Christmas. Parents are asked to give permission for the use of photographs of their child at the time of starting school. Everyone appreciates that it is impossible to take photos etc. without including others in the shot. However, please be aware that there are a few children for whom permission is not given, and whose parents do not wish their child to appear on social media websites, such as Facebook etc.

OPERATION ENCOMPASS

The school is part of the Encompass project which is run jointly between schools and Devon and Cornwall Police. Operation Encompass is the reporting to schools, prior to the start of the next school day, when a child or young person has exposed to, or involved in, any domestic incident. Operation Encompass ensures that a member of the school staff, known as a Key Adult, will liaise with the police and use the information that has been shared, in confidence, while ensuring that the school is able to make provision for possible difficulties experienced by children, or their families, who have been involved in, or exposed to, a domestic abuse incident.

We are keen to offer the best support possible to all our pupils and we believe this is extremely beneficial for all those involved.



HAND WASHING

Health advice given to us suggests that the **best defence** against coughs, colds, sickness and diarrhoea is frequent **hand washing**. Please help us to encourage the children to hand wash as often as necessary. May I also remind you not to return your child to school until **48 hours** have passed following any episodes of **sickness and/or diarrhoea. As you can imagine, school is a very tight knit community and your help in stopping the spread of coughs, colds, sickness and diarrhoea is essential.**
