Year 5 will continue with their tennis coaching with Tom Wyman (LTA coach).

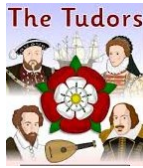
Year 6 will be having a Clayart workshop designing their Clarice Cliff plates.
