



HOW WE SPEND PUPIL PREMIUM at BORINGDON PRIMARY SCHOOL



Family & Pastoral Support £13,000

- Focused on removal of barriers to learning and tracking and enhancing the achievement of learning.
- Provision of a 'drop in' facility to parents requiring emotional support.
- Individual & group sessions for children to improve self-esteem and behaviour in classrooms.

Learning Mentor £2,520

- External support for children to build social skills & Self-esteem.

Intervention Groups & Precision Teaching £11,610

- Small groups teaching to raise attainment & support children with specific difficulties

Additional TA support £5,850

- Small group work targeting children who are not making expected progress



Boost teacher support for Pupil Premium & Service Children £8,500

- Provision of targeted support for children who are not expected levels of progress
- Improve staff / pupil ratio
- Improve quality of teaching and learning

Intensive reading Support £4,000

- Targeted support for children requiring additional support

Subsidised residential Trips & Mast School Holiday activities £600

- To enable all children to take part in outdoor and residential activities to boost self-esteem and confidence



Training for Teacher & TA's £1,000

- Development of staff skills

Purchase of specialised Learning resources £7,000



Teacher Release £2,500

- To deliver rigour in tracking progress of children and ensuring appropriate intervention are put in place

Multi – Agency Support Team £4,230

- To provide specialist support to pupils

Lunch Club £350

- To help children requiring social and emotional support

Events for Service Children £500

- To foster mutual support

Monitoring & Support of Children adopted from care £3,800

- To provide additional support for adopted children
