## Safer Internet Day

Safer Internet Day 2017 will be celebrated globally on Tuesday 7th February with the slogan 'Be the change: Unite for a better internet'.



Coordinated in the UK by the UK Safer Internet Centre the celebration sees hundreds of organisations get involved to help promote the safe, responsible and positive use of digital technology for children and young people. The day offers the opportunity to highlight positive uses of technology and to explore the role we all play in helping to create a better and safer online community.

The UK Safer Internet Centre – a partnership of three leading charities; Childnet, the South West Grid for Learning and the Internet Watch Foundation – provide resources for children, schools and families, and tools for getting involved at [www.saferinternetday.org.uk](http://www.saferinternetday.org.uk). You will find lots of useful information and advice on this website. In school, Class 2 have been thinking about their 'digital footprint' and we have created 'footprints' to remind us that every time you go online you leave a trail. We explored how to have a SMART attitude to your digital footprints and how we can stay safe. On Tuesday we will have a special assembly to be the change and unite for a better internet!

The Cornwall Music Education Hub presents a series of concerts in venues across Cornwall


28th February - Hall for Cornwall, Truro
