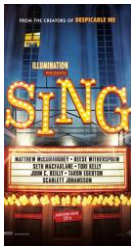
Wildlife Champs

Community Partnership Heavitree Schools Survey (Ladysmith)



The Exeter Community Partnership are asking families to take part in a survey which will close at midnight on Sunday 11th March. Paper copies will be available from the office for anyone who would prefer to complete it in this way.

The Community Partnership Project is a Partnership between Exeter City Futures, University of Exeter, and Exeter City Council. They are partnering with the Heavitree Community, local schools and sustainable transport organisation Sustrans, to better understand how people typically travel to and from school and why they choose this mode of transport.
