

SPORTS PREMIUM 2015/16

How will The Dale Hall be spending the 2015/16 Sports Premium and who will benefit?

The Sports Premium subsidises the employment of Mr Westcott as Sports Coach. Employing a Sports Coach enhances PE and School Sport across the school in four key areas:

High Quality Teaching and up-skilling of others

All our pupils from Reception to Year 6 are provided with two high quality PE lessons every week. Mr Westcott teaches the outdoor PE provision and the class teacher teaches the indoor provision.

The Sports Coach and PE Leader liaise to organise CPD opportunities for our teachers to enhance knowledge and skills.

Leading School Sports Clubs

Mr Westcott is responsible for organising and managing an extensive list of school clubs. These change termly to coincide with our school sport competition diary, which provides sporting opportunities for pupils from year 1 up to year 6. It is our aim to engage 50% of our pupils in physical activities as part of our after school club provision.

Leadership

Mr Westcott works with the Sports Captains by training them to lead, manage and officiate in our School Games activities.

School Sport Participation

Dale Hall is both School Games and Ipswich Primary School Sports Association (IPSSA) members, benefitting from two extensive competition calendars. Mr Westcott is responsible for organising and managing participation in these events with the aim of providing the pupils with the best opportunity to participate and compete to the highest level they can.

The Sports Premium is also used to employ specialist Coaches that engage our pupils in additional activities through organised extra-curricular clubs.

How Will Impact Be Measured?

The four key areas will be continually monitored and reviewed to ensure as a school we are getting the greatest impact from the Sports Provision funding we receive.

Evidence of the impact the funding is having and our school sport participation can be followed in the school newsletter and on our website.

The Sports Premium has impacted the children at Dale Hall in two main ways:

School Sport Participation

The number and variety of physical activities being offered both during and after school has had a substantial impact on the numbers of pupils accessing physical activity outside of the curriculum with 33% of pupils currently attending Sports Clubs provided by the school.

These clubs are continuing to grow and currently include basketball, cross country, football, futsal, high 5 netball, multi-skills, quick-sticks hockey, tag rugby & 3 a-side.

School Sport Competition

The number of inter school sport competitions that Dale Hall has entered during the 2015/16 academic year has increased and resulted in a number of sporting successes.

To date, the school has entered and placed in the following events:-

IPSSG Claydon & Westbourne Boys Football Tournament – 2nd (Silver Certificate)
IPSSG Claydon & Westbourne Tag Rugby Tournament – 4th
IPSSG Sports Hall Athletics Level 2 Finals – 3rd (Bronze Certificate)
IPSSG Basketball Competition – 3rd (Bronze Certificate) *Invited to County Finals*
Inspire Suffolk Boys Football Tournament – 4th
IPSSG Futsal Tournament – 2nd (Silver Certificate)

In addition, the high 5 Netball team is currently unbeaten (W10 D0 L0) in the 'IPSSA Girls' Small Schools Netball League with only 2 games to play.

The Football team play in the 'IPSSA Boys' Medium School Football League and have 4 fixtures remaining.
