

SPORTS PREMIUM 2016/17

How will The Dale Hall be spending the 2016/17 Sports Premium and who will benefit?

The Sports Premium subsidises the employment of Mr Westcott as Sports Coach. Employing a Sports Coach enhances PE and School Sport across the school in four key areas:

High Quality Teaching and up-skilling of others

All our pupils from Reception to Year 6 are provided with two high quality PE lessons every week. Mr Westcott teaches the outdoor PE provision and the class teacher teaches the indoor provision.

The Sports Coach organises CPD opportunities for our teachers to enhance knowledge and skills.

Leading School Sports Clubs

Mr Westcott is responsible for organising and managing an extensive list of school clubs. These change termly to coincide with our school sport competition diary, which provides sporting opportunities for pupils from year 1 up to year 6. It is our aim to engage 50% of our pupils in physical activities as part of our after school club provision.

Leadership

Mr Westcott works with the Sports Captains by training them to lead, manage and officiate in our School Games activities.

School Sport Participation

Dale Hall is both School Games and Ipswich Primary School Sports Association (IPSSA) members, benefitting from two extensive competition calendars. Mr Westcott is responsible for organising and managing participation in these events with the aim of providing the pupils with the best opportunity to participate and compete to the highest level they can.

The Sports Premium is also used to employ specialist Coaches that engage our pupils in additional activities through organised extra-curricular clubs.

How Will Impact Be Measured?

The four key areas will be continually monitored and reviewed to ensure as a school we are getting the greatest impact from the Sports Provision funding we receive.
