Micro habitats.

- ▶ Micro habitats are small habitats. Micro means little.
- ▶ A **micro-habitat** is a very specific, small home environment for plants, animals and insects.

Examples of micro habitats.

- ▶ Drainpipe
- ▶ Individual trees or bushes or plants
- ▶ under a stone
- ▶ Grassy areas
- ▶ Under a pile of leaves or sticks
- ▶ a pile of logs
- ▶ Ponds or lakes



Habitats

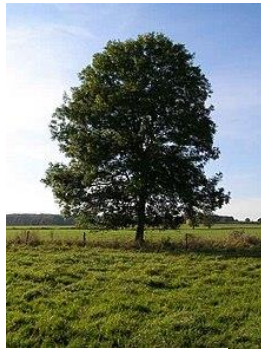
Animals live in habitats that have all of their basic needs (food, air, water, space, shelter).
