Penalty Notice Reminder (10 sessions or more)

A reminder to all Parents/Carers, the Government does not support parents/carers taking children out of school during term time for holiday. Absence requests will only be authorised if it is classed as 'exceptional circumstances'. Any request for leave should be made in writing on an absence request form which can be obtained from the school office. If a holiday (unauthorised absence) is taken during term time and is 10 sessions or more (5 days or more) then this will automatically be referred to Cornwall Council for a Penalty Notice.

'If you decide to still take your child/ children out of school, without permission, you will be committing an offence under the Education Act 1996. We may refer the matter to Cornwall Council who may decide to take legal action against you. A penalty notice can be issued under Section 444A and 444B of the Education Act 1996. This carries a fine of £60 (per child, per parent) if paid within 21 days or £120 if paid after this but within 28 days. Failure to pay the penalty notice may result in Court action. Persistent absences not authorised by the school may result in a prosecution in the Magistrates Court, leading to fines up to £2,500 and/or custodial sentences. The Council may also apply for the costs incurred in taking the matter to Court.'
