Dear Parents/ Carers,

The information below has been designed to help you to understand how we will support your child's education in the event that they are unable to attend school. This could be due to the COVID pandemic, symptoms or isolation.

**Day One of Self-Isolation** – (awaiting test results, isolating due to family member being positive)

On day one of your child not being in school, please use your child's login for eSchools and the internet to access a variety of websites for general work. On their class home page are activities for them to complete. Here is a suggested timetable:

<b>Maths</b>	30-60 minutes	TT Rockstars / White Rose Maths (available on class eSchools page) worksheets and videos
<b>English Writing</b>	30-60 minutes	Choose an activity from the class novel study section of your class eSchools page.
<b>English Reading</b>	30-60 minutes	Read your school reading book or read an online story using the researchify link - <a href="https://researchify.co.uk/">https://researchify.co.uk/</a> / <a href="#">Oak Academy</a> / Oxford owl
<b>Topic</b>	30-90 minutes	Pick an activity from your topic home learning document that will link to your topic in class.

Please see your class Seesaw for updated tasks for your class.

This learning is instant and ready for your child to access so that there are no missed opportunities for learning. It also allows your child's teacher time to get up to date resources ready that are in line with the learning taking place in the classroom. These will be available from day two onward (please see table on next page).



## Day 2 Onwards

<p>My child is absent because they are awaiting test results or our household is required to self-isolate for two weeks.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- The rest of their school bubble are attending school and being taught as normal.</li><li>- The rest of their school bubble are attending school and being taught as normal, so the teacher will not be able to respond to work or queries until the end of the day.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Maths</b> – white rose uploaded to eSchools. 1 lesson per day. These will be mirroring the maths being covered in the classroom at that time. This may be a combination of white rose maths videos (the scheme used to support lessons in school), where appropriate the PowerPoints shared in the classroom and resources/worksheets used in the classroom. Answers will be provided for self-marking at home.</li><li>• <b>English</b> – tasks uploaded to eSchools following the sequence of learning happening in the classroom. The quantity will be dependent on age/year of your child. Some/all of these must be ‘handed in’ to your child’s class teacher via the message button on eSchools for marking. English tasks will consist of Reading, Writing, and Spelling and Grammar activities in line with the class timetable.</li><li>• <b>Phonics for EYFS and KS1</b> will be set by the class teacher focusing on previously learnt sounds. Links to appropriate RWI YouTube videos will be shared.</li><li>• <b>Topic task(s)</b> following the lessons being covered in class that week. These will be a combination of topic tasks and the Government’s ‘Oak Academy’ lessons. The will be set by the teacher in the topic section of the class web page. These must be ‘handed in’ to your child’s class teacher via the message button on eSchools for marking.</li></ul>
<p>My child’s whole bubble is not permitted to attend school because they, or another member of their bubble, have tested positive for Covid-19.</p> <p>Or we enter another ‘lockdown’ with total school closure.</p>	<p>As above and in addition:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Video Support</b> – Your child’s class teacher will upload a video daily to lay out the day.</li><li>• <b>Learning support</b> – Your child’s class teacher will be available between 9:00am and 12:00pm and 13:00pm and 4:00pm for support and to guide the pupils.</li><li>• <b>Feedback</b> will be more bespoke to individuals to identify any misconceptions and address these.</li><li>• <b>End of week assemblies-</b> delivered by Mr Gynn and Mrs Rees to keep in touch with the children, celebrate learning and help boost children’s morale.</li></ul>

Please note, if your child is unwell with Covid symptoms we would not expect them to submit work until they feel well enough to. Please keep in contact with your child’s teacher each day to let them know how they are getting on.

We understand this is a lot of information to process. We are sharing this with you so that you are prepared and aware of what we have in place for your child if they need access to remote learning. This will be different to how we worked during lockdown as there is the expectation that children will be in daily contact with their class teacher and will submit work for the teacher to see. This will all be done via eSchools.
