

Teaching e-Safety across the school

Pupils in every class across the school will sign an Acceptable Use Policy (Separate Infant and Junior versions). The points in the Policy are discussed with the pupils before the document is signed.

In addition, teaching of e-Safety (as detailed in the Computing National Curriculum) will take place as follows:

KEY STAGE 1 (and EYFS)

Use technology safely and respectfully, keeping personal information private; identify where to go for help and support when they have concerns about content or contact on the Internet or other online technologies.

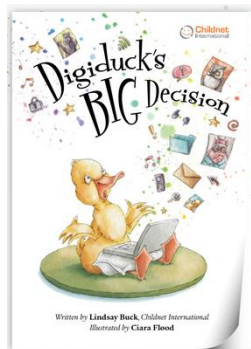

Show and discuss issues raised in Hector's World Cartoons 1-3

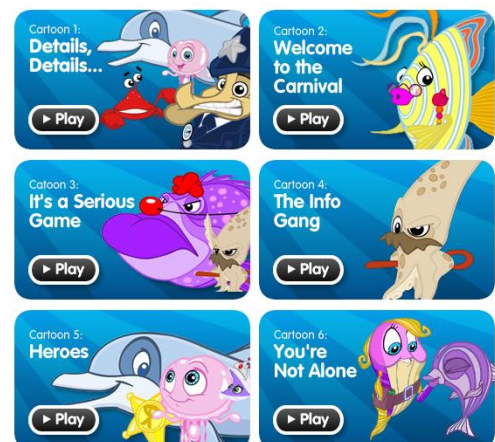

KEY STAGE 2
