# The School Day

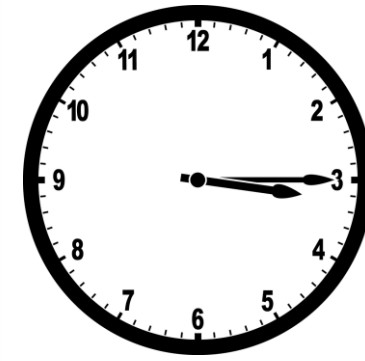
8:50am – The day begins

- Gates open at 8:30am – where there will be a member of staff on duty in every class ready to receive the children
- Children to enter class by 8:45am at the latest
- Inner School gates & doors will be locked at 8:50am, the official start time – late arrivals at this point will need to report to the school office
- At the end of the day the gates will open at 3.00pm
- Children will be dismissed from their classroom doors at 3:15pm
- In EYFS & Key Stage 1, children will be dismissed to their known adult. If other adults will be picking up your children, prior notification will need to be given.

# Travelling to School



- Walking is definitely the best option! There are lots of benefits: health, environmental, safety, parking & congestion
- Alternatively, we have a bike and scooter shelter
- If you do need to travel by car, please park with care and consideration as the safety of our pupils is of paramount importance
- There are a limited number of parking bays and drop off bays
- Drop off expectations will be shared further at the Meet the Teacher event
- We want to ensure systems are in place to help alleviate traffic congestion working with the community to ensure periods before and after school are as calm as can be
- Early gate opening (8:30am) and supervised entrances, provides a staggered drop off time.



# Before and After School Club

- ▶ This is an 'optional service' that we will be providing to support the needs of our community, being particularly mindful of working parents
- ▶ The provision before school begins at 8:00am (Early Birds) – not a breakfast club
- ▶ After School Club finishes at 5:15pm (3:15pm – 5:15pm) – light snack provided
- ▶ For pupils from any year group
- ▶ This will not be available until week beginning 16<sup>th</sup> September
- ▶ The cost of before school provision is: TBC
- ▶ The cost of after school provision is: TBC
- ▶ No Holiday provision initially
- ▶ We are in discussions with external providers about the possibility of establishing a dedicated breakfast club and after school club and will keep you informed as this progresses

# Our Classes

We are opening school with a total of 5 classes: two reception classes, one Year 1 class, one Year 2 class and a mixed Key Stage 2 class.

All classes are named after explorers (EYFS), discoverers (Years 1 & 2), innovators (Years 3 & 4) or pioneers (Years 5 & 6)
