The top student in each year group who gains the most **PRIDE** points for each separate category is awarded **CHAMPION** status (EG Equality CHAMPION)

The top male and female student in each year group who attain the highest total number of **PRIDE** points across all categories are awarded **PRIDE AMBASSADOR** status

All students with 100% attendance (term) are awarded **ATTENDANCE CHAMPION** status
 All students with 100% attendance (year) are awarded **ATTENDANCE AMBASSADOR** status

Additional **PRIDE** Awards are presented for outstanding contribution by Form Tutors and Year Leaders

PRIDE points are also awarded for improved and sustained commitment over a period of time:
 PERSONAL CHALLENGES / PROJECTS / CLUBS / TEAMS / BEST PROGRAMMES / EVENTS / FUNDRAISING
 POSITIVE CHANGES IN PATTERNS OF LATENESS / ABSENCE / BEHAVIOUR
 OUTSTANDING WORK AND EFFORT OVER A PERIOD OF TIME
