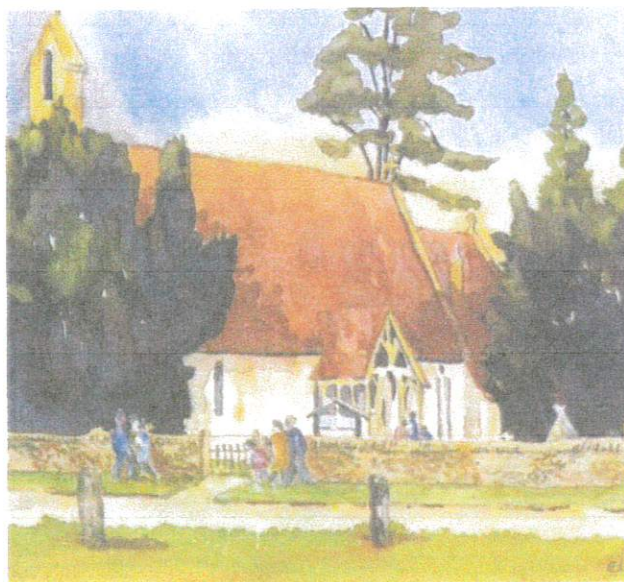


## THE PLACE OF SILENCE AND MEDITATION IN WORSHIP

## Footprints: A service of remembrance for the loss of a child

On Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2019 at 7.30pm, we will be holding our annual Footprints Service; this year it will take place at Holy Trinity Church, Church Path, Lane End, HP14 3HD. As in previous years the service will take place the weekend before Mother's Day, a time when the loss of a child can be particularly difficult. It may be a time of year when the pain of losing a child is difficult to bear, whether that loss is recent or many years ago. It may also be a time when remembering is important and a significant part of the pathway through grief.

The Footprints Service is a service for anyone who has lost a child during pregnancy or at any age or stage of life or has been affected by such a loss, whether parent, grandparent, teacher, friend or family member. All are welcome.

Footprints will offer space to remember your child or children and the opportunity to light a candle in their memory if you wish. There will be music, readings and prayers included as part of our time of remembering. Refreshments will be served after the service.
