Dear parents and carers,

Ms Jeeti Sehra will be joining us in September as our new Senior Teacher and class teacher of Class Two. Ms Sehra is an outstanding practitioner with extensive knowledge and experience working in EYFS and KS1.

Ms Sehra is currently working as an Advanced Skills Teacher; developing teachers' skills within the classroom. She also has extensive experience in leadership and I look forward working alongside Ms Sehra going forward.

Class 4 will welcome back a familiar face – Mrs Louise Alvarez. Mrs Alvarez will job share with Mrs Whayman-Bailey teaching every Friday. For those who are new to Cadmore End School, Mrs Alvarez joined shortly after I started in September 2017 and supported the school through a successful OFSTED. She is an outstanding practitioner who is very much loved by her pupils. Mrs Alvarez left June 2019 to have her first child.

By the time children return in September, it's likely that they would have had 23 weeks of disrupted learning. The Governors and I though, are extremely confident that our team of dedicated teachers with the support of



our support staff, will identify and rapidly close gaps in the children's learning. More importantly, they will regain their thirst for learning and love of school life.
