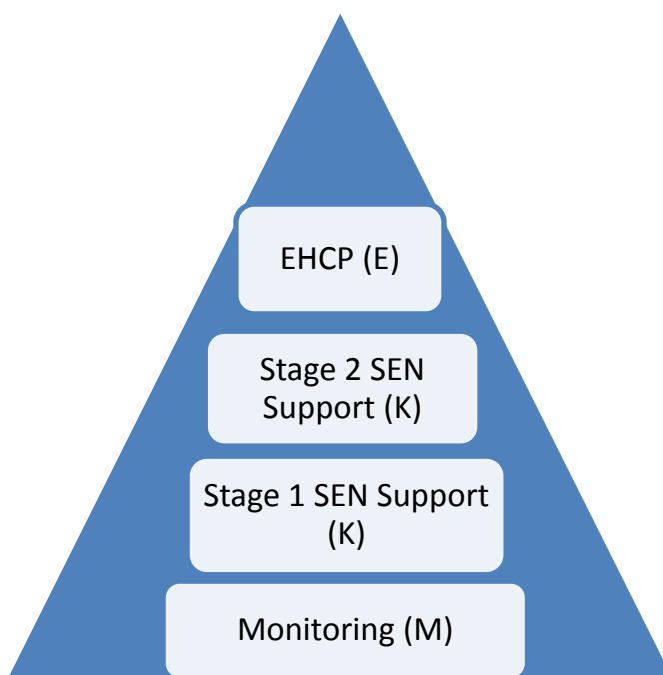


The Special Educational Needs Team at Brooklands Middle consists of the SENDCo (Gayle Raybould), Assistant SENDCo (Michelle Tipper) and SEN Administrator (Debbie Cripps).

We are also fortunate to have a trained interventions teacher and mentor who delivers high quality support on a (one to one and small group basis) to students identified as needing additional support.

There are currently 18 LSA's (Learning Support Assistants) providing 1:1 and whole class support for children identified by class teachers and the SEN Team.

Our policy is to support children through the delivery of quality first teaching within the classroom, and only withdraw students for Stage 1 support when all strategies have been tried without success.
