Support received 2016/17

Impact 2016/2017

- 30% of pupils who had not met expected standard by end of Y6 met or exceeded ARE by the end of Y7 in Maths
- 54% of pupils who had not met expected standard by end of Y6 had made expected or better than expected progress by the end of Y7.
- 60% of pupils who had not met expected standard by end of y6 are predicted to achieve ARE by the end of KS3 and so are predicted to achieve a standard pass (4+) in Maths by end of KS4
- 28% of pupils who had not met expected standard by the end of Y6 had met the standard by the end of Y7 in English reading and writing.
- 71% of pupils who had not met expected standard by the end of Y6 are forecast to meet ARE by the end of KS3 in English reading and writing.

Actions for 2017/8

Expected Funding for 2017/18: £14,000

- **To apply same principles of 1:1 tuition and use of HLTA to English;**
- **To continue to use effective strategies from 2016/17 to continue to raise standards;**
- **To purchase laptops for English department to support 7E5 writing**
