This Week...

In Maths we have been looking at place value; we have been reading, writing and demonstrating our understanding of numbers up to one million. In our English lessons we have continued to read our Class Novel: we have been scanning the text for key information and writing the next part of the story using action, description and dialogue. In Science we have begun our topic about animals which explores the theory of evolution and adaptation to various habitats and environments. We are thinking about the Christian Value of thankfulness in worship and exploring 'Life as a Journey' in R.E. Our Geography lesson involved using atlases to locate continents, oceans and countries and we have begun researching different countries and looking at their geographical features.
