It was lovely to welcome Class 3 back into school on Tuesday! They have had a wonderful week.

This half term, we have started a new topic – The Iron Man. In English, we will be reading, discussing and exploring The Iron Man written by Ted Hughes. In particular, focussing on the language used to describe characters and settings. Maths lessons will concentrate on counting on in steps and multiplication. In Science, we have started exploring different forces and magnets. The children spent time exploring different objects and how they moved across a surface. In History, the children began to consider the dates of the Stone Age and think about what they would be interested in learning about this period.

Next Week...

In English, we will continue reading The Iron Man. Maths will focus on written methods of multiplication. Science will investigate forces in more detail. History lessons will concentrate on the Stone Age and what tools the early humans used during this time. RE will explore the importance and significance of light.
