Year 3 Trip – Royal Cornwall Museum – Ancient Egypt Workshop

On Monday 3rd December our Year 3 children will visit the Royal Cornwall Museum, Truro to participate in an Ancient Egypt Workshop.

The visit will entail two guided workshops, examining Egyptian artefacts found in tombs as well as exploring the Egyptian gallery. Children will also take part in activities relating to the process of mummification. After the workshops, the children will have time to explore the museum in greater depth.

We will be travelling to Truro by bus, departing Sandy Hill Academy at 9am and returning to school before the end of the day.

We are requesting a voluntary contribution of £7.50 per child for this trip. Please note there is no obligation to contribute and pupils will not be treated differently according to whether or not their parents have contributed. However, the trip will only be able to take place if the school receives sufficient contributions. In the event that the trip has to be cancelled a full refund will be made.
