showed real sportsmanship. It was fantastic to see so many of you supporting the children at sports day. Thank you all for coming and contributing to the days success!

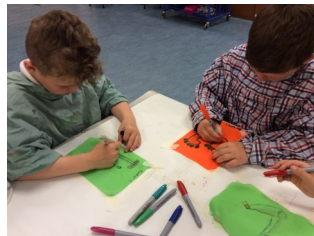
