## **St Austell Torchlight Carnival – 16 November 2019**

It's that time of year again and as the evenings draw in so the Winter festivities begin.

We are very excited to confirm that we are once again participating in the annual St. Austell Torchlight Carnival. This fantastic community event takes place on Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> November 2019.

This year we are running two workshops in school for parents, grandparents and/or guardians to attend alongside their child, where you will be able to create your lantern together. The two workshops will take place on Tuesday 5 November, you may attend either in the morning from 8:45 - 11:30am or during the afternoon from 2 - 4pm.

The cost of the workshop is £2 per child, with monies received going towards the cost of materials for making the lantern. By signing up to the workshop, you are committing to coming to the Torchlight Carnival and being responsible for your child at the event.

Our theme this year is 'Save Our Animals'. The lanterns we make will be of animals that are extinct or close to extinction.

The carnival starts at John Keay House, where we meet at 4:45pm (for judging to begin at 5pm) and finishes at the One Stop Shop (next to Pondhu School).

Please note all children that attend must be accompanied by an adult. To reserve your child's place and make a lantern for the carnival please sign into your ParentPay account to make payment and complete the consent, providing the name of the adult who will accompany the child.
