Infant Bedtime Stories - 14th October at 4:00pm to 5:00pm

Dear Parents and Carers

This year we are holding our annual Infant bedtime stories on 14th October from 4:00-5:00pm. This is always a fantastic evening and we regularly have 98% of the infant children return to school to take part. As always, we ask that your child is dropped to the outside door of their own classroom at 4:00pm, dressed in their pyjamas with slippers or trainers and, of course, it would not be bedtime stories without their teddy bear to hug (one named teddy bear per child please).

As well as enjoying story time the children will have milk and biscuits. Please let your child's class teacher know if your child has any food allergies that will mean that they will not be able to enjoy these refreshments.

Whilst the children are engaged in bedtime stories there will be parent information workshops taking place for all parents. These workshops are important as they will provide you with the information you need to support your child with the next stages of their schooling.

We will be holding a Phonic Meeting for reception class parents in the school hall.

Year 1 parents will meet in the empty classroom in the new building used to dismiss the Year 3 class.

During this session information on the compulsory national phonic assessment will be discussed. There will also be a workshop for Year 2 parents in the empty classroom in the new building used to dismiss the Year 4 children.

Miss Bussandri and Mrs Osborne will discuss the Key Stage 1 SATs tests that all Year 2 children take in May. All workshops will last the duration of the bedtime stories and will provide you with a chance to discuss the relevant information with your child's class teacher.
