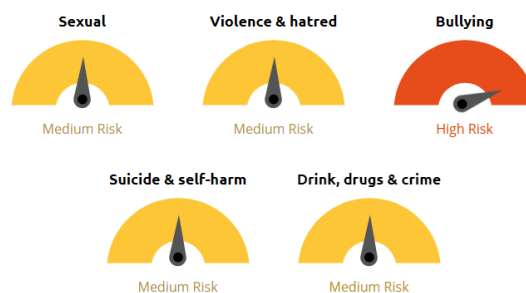
Soft room - 93
