Attendance Policy – Late Arrival

We are pleased to inform you that since we let you know about the changes to our attendance/late policy, there has been a reduction with the attendance/late arrivals throughout the school. Here is a reminder about the changes:

*'The Governors have agreed some changes to our Attendance Policy so that it is in line with guidance from West Sussex on the recording of children arriving late for school. These changes came in to effect on Monday 16th April and the policy is now available to read on the school website. As before, the doors on the playground open for children at 8.35am and children are expected in class when the registers are taken by 8.45am. If your child arrives after 8.50am, they will need to report to the school office to be signed in before going to the classroom; this will be marked as 'late' (L). Children arriving after 9.00am will be marked as an unauthorised late (U). The Local Authority treat unauthorised late marks in the same way as absences from school and the law states, those children who miss 10 or more sessions in a 10 week period; due to unauthorised absences, may be issued with a Fixed Penalty Notice (FPN). If you have any queries, please do not hesitate to contact the school office. **Please also note that a number of FPN's have been issued this term for holidays taken during term time which we would just like to remind you are unauthorised.***



Trees and Trim Trail

Please can we remind you that children need to be supervised by parents/carers before and after school whilst playing on the trim trail as we have no staff available to be in the playground at this time. Also, we have a lot of beautiful trees on site. We don't want to spoil your fun but some of them are young and not very strong, others are quite old and fragile therefore could we ask that children do not climb the trees as we need to respect and look after them – thank you for your cooperation.
