Maths:

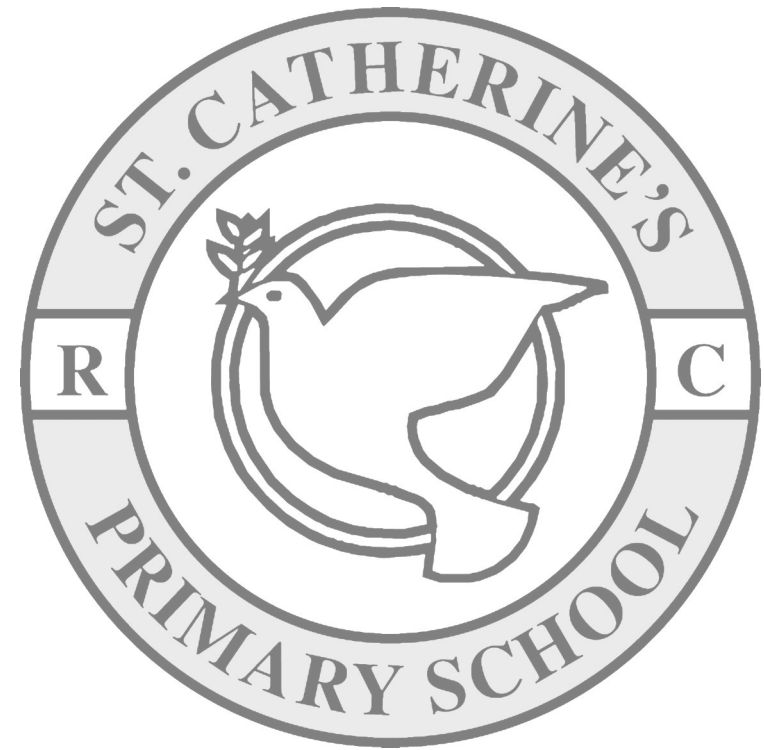
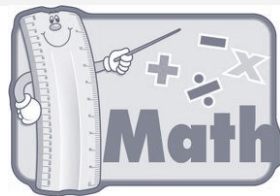
Help me to practice all my times tables. I can show you some fun rhymes that I have been learning in school to help.

Overview of learning in

Year 4



This half term in Year 4

Our first **RE** topic will be

Christmas followed by Revelation. We will be learning about 'God's revelation of Himself in Jesus.'

In **English** we will be reading a variety of texts linked to each unit to help us expand our vocabulary and be an inspiration for our own writing.

In our writing we will be learning how to write myths, biographies and instructions.

Our **Maths** topics this half term are: place value, multiplication & division, fractions and reasoning about numbers.

My **Science** topic will be

Sound where we will learn about how sound travels.

Our topic this half term is '**What did the Vikings and Anglo-Saxons ever do for us?**

In **PE** we will be working with Mrs Pegg learning tag-rugby.

In **Art week** we will be learning about art techniques in sketching and drawing. We will be studying the works of Leonardo de Vinci.

In our **French** lessons we will be learning the numbers and applying these to real life situations.

Mrs Kernick will be teaching us to exploring pitch in **Music**.

Homework

In agreement with the Friends of St Catherine's Council, homework will be sent home on a Friday and is due back in the following Wednesday.

Reading every child is expected to read for at least 10 minutes every day. We expect the reading record to be signed at least 3 times a week by an adult.

Spelling every child will have spelling homework each week. This will involve learning a set of spellings, with a particular spelling rule.

Maths every child in Key Stage 2 needs to be fluent in their times tables. By the end of Year 4, all children need to know their tables up to 12 x 12.
