To give School Trends enough time to get your order to you before your first day back, we are asking all parents/carers to order as soon as possible. On receipt of your uniform, please get your child to try it on, label it and put it away ready for next term. Please ensure your child wears the correct school uniform in September, including shoes or trainers that are completely black.
