## Holy Cross Hearts Campaign 1st - 14th February

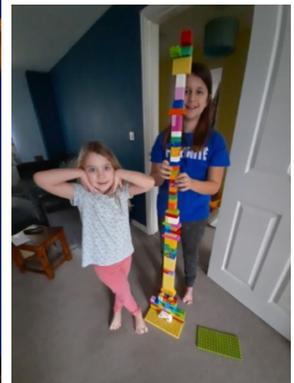
