

# Primary PE Sports Grant Report

## 2014-2015



### **Purpose of Funding**

The Government is determined to secure a significant and lasting legacy from the London 2012 Olympic and Paralympic Games. Developing an enjoyment of sport and physical activity, and promoting a healthy lifestyle in children from an early age. To support this, the Prime Minister announced that the Government is providing additional funding for primary schools to improve the provision of sport and physical education (PE). Every primary school will receive additional funding from an overall allocation of £150m per year for sport and PE in academic years 2013/14 and 2014/15. The funding is ring fenced and can only be spent on improving the provision of PE/sport but schools have been given the freedom to choose how they do this.

At St Margaret's Academy we have developed an action plan in order to continue to improve the quality and breadth of PE and sporting provision, including increasing participation and raising achievement and performance standards for all pupils in sport and PE.
