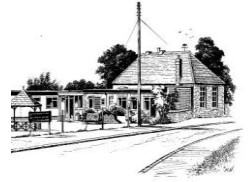

Parking

Please remember some golden rules when parking in Church Lane to reduce stress for other parents and improve safety for children and families:

- ✓ DO NOT PARK in the **drop-off zone** – please keep this area flowing freely
- ✓ **Park sensibly** close to other cars – large gaps that are just too small for a car to park in will take up more space along the lane and make parking harder for others
- ✓ **STAY SLOW** – *never drive fast in the lane* – we are very understanding when people are slightly late due to a delay: please never rush, don't risk a child's safety by driving quickly
- ✓ **Car Share** as much as possible to reduce traffic – take turns to do the school run to help the environment and share the effort with friends.
