- provide reading books, spellings, tables and other homework as appropriate and outlined in the termly curriculum news;
- ensure that children are dismissed promptly.

Headteacher's signature

The family will:

- make sure that our child arrives at school between 8.30am and 8.45am and is collected from school promptly at 3pm or, if attending an after-school club, at the agreed time;
- make sure that our child attends regularly and make contact with the school before 10am on the first day of any unexplained absence;
- make sure our child is appropriately dressed and equipped for school, and that school uniform is named;
- support and encourage the completion and prompt return of any homework set, according to the class timetable arrangements;
- inform the school of any concerns or problems which might affect our child's work or behaviour;
- support school policies and guidelines (available to read in school);
- avoid taking our child on holiday during term time.
