Sessions will run from 09:30 - 16:30 and the children will need to bring a packed lunch and a drink. Session prices are £35 per child (discount for siblings). Our Forest School and Bushcraft activities will always include some of the following:

- ✓ Fire lighting
- ✓ Shelter building
- ✓ Woodland crafts
- ✓ Use of tools such as bow saws, palm drills, secateurs and loppers
- ✓ Basic plant and tree identification
- ✓ Bug hunts, nature walks, animal tracking and habitats
- ✓ And so much more!

The session always ends with hot chocolate and marshmallows around the campfire when we will chat about the things which we enjoyed most about our time in the woods.
