We received responses from 19 adults and 9 children.

The most popular suggestions for improvements from the adults were:

1. provision for older children
2. seating, particularly picnic tables
3. trim trail/obstacle course style equipment

The most popular suggestions for improvements from the children were:

1. more equipment
2. toilets (so they don't have to go home)
3. zip wire



We are looking into options, but we aim to provide:

- Assault course style climbing unit which offers challenge to older children, should include monkey bars and slide.
- Separate role play equipment for toddlers.
- Seating/picnic tables
- Tree planting for summer shade.

Unfortunately, due to the cricket outfield, there is not the space for a zip wire.
