<i>PSED</i>	Being Me:- knowing that I am special and belong to different groups
<i>Communication and Language</i>	Listening and joining in with stories, poems and songs about our topic of Being Me
<i>Physical Development</i>	Moving in different ways knowing how to use space and stop. Using our fingers in different ways
<i>Literacy</i>	Telling stories and remembering key parts. Taking part in phonics and learning how to write my name
<i>Mathematics</i>	Counting, reading, writing and using numbers to 5; recognising and naming basic shapes
<i>Understanding the World</i>	Finding out about themselves and what happens when we grow; using the remote controlled toys
