- ✚ Promote British values: democracy; the rule of law; individual liberty; mutual respect; and tolerance of those with different faiths and beliefs.
- ✚ Ensure that the UNCRC Rights of the Child are at the heart of all that we say and do.
- ✚ Contact parents if there is a problem with attendance and/or punctuality.
- ✚ Let parents know about any concerns or problems that affect their child's work or behaviour.
- ✚ Send home an annual report at the end of the school year.
- ✚ Keep parents informed about school activities through letters home, Schoolzine, school's website and Twitter account.
- ✚ Arrange meetings to discuss the progress of children, indicating strengths and areas for development through individual targets.
- ✚ Contact and share information with professional agencies if there are safeguarding concerns regarding your child.

## 1. AS A PUPIL I SHALL:

- ✚ Attend school every school day and on time by 8.55 am each day.
- ✚ Look neat and smart, wear my school uniform and PE/sports uniform for PE lessons and sports events. Wear school shoes in class and black pumps / black trainers for PE.
- ✚ Remember to bring things I need when they are needed, e.g. Forest School kit.
- ✚ Work hard to achieve my targets and always do my best.
- ✚ Uphold the class charter to know my rights and the rights of others.
- ✚ Follow school's code of conduct and school policies.
- ✚ Follow the Acceptable Use Policy for children when using the Internet, mobile phone or other new technology.
- ✚ Be kind and caring and respect other's culture, race, values, religion, feelings and beliefs.
- ✚ Tell someone at school if I have a problem, am worried or unhappy.
- ✚ Be responsible for everything I do and behave in a safe and respectful manner.

## 2. AS PARENTS/CARERS WE SHALL:

- ✚ Send my/our child to school every school day and on time, by 8.55am, properly equipped and attired.
- ✚ **Not leave Reception, infant or year 3 children unattended in the playground before their teacher collects them at 8.55 or Junior children before 8.45 am.**
- ✚ Only take holidays in holiday time and ensure my/our child attends all school sessions.
- ✚ Inform the school about any concerns or problems that might affect my/our child's work or behaviour.
- ✚ Support the school's policies and guidelines for *behaviour (Behaviour Regulation and Anti-bullying policies) and ensure my child adheres to the school's Acceptable Use (of new technologies) Policy for Children.*
- ✚ *Support my/our child in homework and other opportunities for home learning.*
- ✚ Attend parents' evenings and discussions about my/our child's progress.
- ✚ Work in partnership with the school to develop positive attitudes towards those from different cultures and races and with different religions, feelings, values and beliefs.
- ✚ Foster a positive attitude towards education and the school and use discretion when discussing issues or grievances in front of children as these may have a negative effect on their time at school.
- ✚ Support school in following national, local and school policy and procedures with regard to safeguarding children.
